## Standing as a candidate-parish elections

- Electoral Commission guidance
  - o eligibility, disqualifications (Elections Act 2022)
- Must complete:
  - PARISH nomination paper
  - consent to nomination (7 pages)
  - home address (2 pages)
- Political party candidates— certificate of authorisation, use of emblem
- Must be hand delivered to designated council office
- Delivered by candidate or someone they trust
- Earliest date becomes a candidate 25 March



### Nomination form

- Complete top sections before two subscribers sign
- Subscribers must be on 1 March electoral register
- Subscriber must be registered in the parish area (eg if parish warded then that ward)
- Description can be left blank, one of the political party name or one of their descriptions\*, independent, or up to six words\*\*
- \* must be authorised by political party certificate of authorisation
- \*\*
  a description that is not likely to lead electors to associate the candidate with a registered political party

## Consent to nomination

- All SEVEN pages must be submitted
- Qualifications complete all that apply (strike out ones that do not apply)
- Cannot sign earlier than one calendar month before deadline to submit
- Witness- can be anyone but must match home address form
- Candidate date of birth- at least 18 years old

- For home addresses in England:
  - if the address is within a district for which there is a district council, that district:
  - if the address is within a county in which there are no districts with councils, that county;
  - if the address is within a London borough, that London borough;
  - if the address is within the City of London (including the Inner and Middle Temples), the City of London; and
  - if the address is within the Isles of Scilly, the Isles of Scilly
- For home addresses in Wales:
  - if the address is within a county, that county;
  - if the address is within a county borough, that county borough
- For home addresses in Scotland:
  - the local government area in which the address is situated
- For home addresses in Northern Ireland:
  - the local government district in which the address is situated

Note: The relevant area should be given in the format described above and is not the ward or parish, nor should the local <u>authority</u> name be given in full

## Political party candidates

- Complete certificate of authorisation
- Registered description /political party name MUST match nomination form exactly
- Registered description /political party name MUST be registered with Electoral Commission
- Candidate can request use of registered political party emblem by completing form

To accompany the nomination of a candidate standing on behalf of a registered political party. (Note: candidates standing on behalf of two or more parties require a certificate from each party and each must allow the same registered joint description to be used).

This certificate must be issued by the registered Nominating Officer of the party or by a person authorised to sign on their behalf.

This certificate authorises the candidate to use a specific registered description or the name of the party as registered with the Electoral Commission, or to use 'any registered description or the party name as registered with the Electoral Commission'.

This authorised party name or description can then be included by the candidate on the nomination form. It is this which will appear as their description on the ballot paper. Party names and registered descriptions are listed on the Electoral Commission's website ({HYPERLINK "http://search.electoralcommission.org.uk"}).

This form is only effective if delivered for a candidate standing on behalf of a political party to the Returning Officer by no later than 4pm on the last day to deliver nominations.

Candidates standing on behalf of more than one political party and using a joint description may choose one emblem from one of the parties that you are standing for. Please indicate the name of the party and the emblem name in the 'Emblem to be used' box above.

# Submitting nominations

- Refer to notice of election for where nominations can be delivered
- Please use the booking system for appointments
- An informal check is provided at the appointment before formal submission
- Multiple nominations contact us and we can book a longer appointment
- Deliver by hand candidate or some they trust



### Points to note

- Complete the parish/parish ward name and date of election at the top of each document
- Contact details for candidates
- Name and address of subscribers
- Candidates can stand in more than one parish if eligible
- Candidates can stand in more than one ward of SAME parish but must withdraw by the withdrawal deadline (4pm on Wednesday 2 April) so only remains nominated in one ward



## After close of nominations

Statement of persons nominated published 4pm on Thursday 3 April

### **Contested elections**

- Take place on 1 May and combined with any other election in same area on that day
- Further information for candidates and agents at contested elections regarding the election process including the count will follow after 3 April



# After close of nominations (continued)

#### **Uncontested elections**

- Candidates are duly elected
- Candidates must complete and submit election expenses forms including NIL returns

#### Quorate

Unfilled seats can be filled by co-option

### Inquorate

 We will contact you in due course after 3 April as further election to be scheduled for unfilled seats
